SUNDAY 5th OCTOBER LANGLEY AND THE KEDERMISTER LIBRARY (Figure of 8) 8.2 miles. *Two circular walks* (3.9 and 4.3 miles) through Langley Park, along the Grand Union Canal and the centre of Langley with visit of the historic St Mary's Church and the Kedermister Library which was founded before 1631.
